

**SECTION 19 EXTRACTIVE INDUSTRIAL (EI) ZONE
REGULATIONS**

The Extractive Industrial (EI) Zone is intended to apply to any such lands within the Township of Wellesley where resource extraction exists or is proposed.

19.1 PERMITTED USES

No land shall be used and no buildings or structures shall be erected, used or altered in the Extractive Industrial (EI) Zone except for the following purposes:

- Pit;
- Quarry;
- Farming;
- Arboretum;
- Forestry use;
- Accessory uses to the above permitted uses.

19.2 BUFFER STRIP

Where an Extractive Industrial (EI) Zone abuts any Residential Zone a buffer strip shall be provided in accordance with the provisions of the Aggregate Resources Act and the applicable development agreement.

19.3 EXCEPTIONS – EXTRACTIVE INDUSTRIAL (EI) ZONE

19.3.1 Defined Area

EI-1 as shown on Schedule “A”, Map 41 to this By-law

Additional Permitted Use

- Asphalt plant;
- Consolidation of equipment, buildings and structures.

19.3.2 Defined Area

EI-2 as shown on Schedule “A”, Map 41, to this By-law.

Additional Permitted Uses

- A ready-mix concrete plant.

19.3.3 Defined Area

EI-3 as shown in Schedule “A”, Map 41, to this By-law.

Additional Permitted Uses

- Equipment storage buildings;
- Redi-mix concrete plant;
- Asphalt batching plant;
