Reminder Changes to Tax Due Dates

Property Tax due dates have changed to the last business day of February, April, August and October. The remaining 2023 tax due dates are August 31 & October 31

REMINDER: Payments need to be received in the township office on the due date to avoid penalty, this includes payments received by mail. Canada Post has changed their processes and time in transit may be longer than expected. To ensure online payments are on time, payment should be made in advance of the due date.
