



## Council and Committee of the Whole Meeting Schedule

The Council and Committee of the Whole meeting schedule is set annually. The 2024 meeting schedule has been set on a frequency of second and fourth Tuesday of each month, except for the months of July, August and December where one Council meeting has been scheduled. If you have previously submitted proof, you are not required to resubmit.

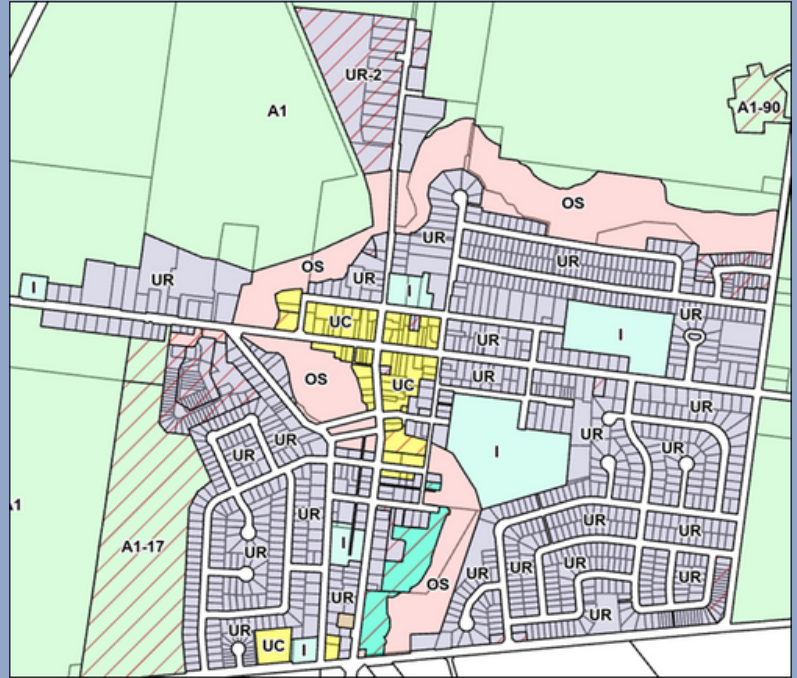

## The Township is Developing its First Geographic Information System

Geographic Information Systems (GIS) are used to visualize, analyze, and interpret geospatial data. GIS helps us in understanding our municipal assets (like roads, bridges, and pipes) and how they work together to serve our community. Moving forward, we plan to use GIS to facilitate several online public interactions with geographic data pertaining to the township. For example, staff is working on an online interactive zoning map that will allow anyone to easily look up the zoning of their property. ### DEPARTMENT SPOTLIGHT Public Works

#### Winter on-street parking

Traffic and Parking By-law Amendment 21/2023 restricts on-street parking from December 1 to March 31, 4:00am. to 9:00am. daily. Keeping vehicles clear from the roadway ensures safe and efficient road maintenance. Thank you for your cooperation and adherence to the by-law.

#### Snow plow safety

Municipal snow clearing equipment is identified with blue flashing lights. Remember to give extra room to snow clearing vehicles as they are large and require the use of extended blades and plows which can be tricky to navigate in tight spaces.

#### Sidewalk snow clearing

In accordance with By-law 12/2011 it is the responsibility of the owner or occupant of every building to remove snow and/or ice from the sidewalk within twenty-four hours after the end of a snowfall. Sidewalks are used for daily exercise and travel of residents and guests of the Township, please ensure the sidewalks adjacent to your house are clear and safe for use.

#### Staying safe in the snow

It is important to remind kids that playing in the snowbanks along the roadside is very dangerous. Snow clearing can be done at anytime of the day so be sure to stay clear of these areas on the way to and from school or on the weekends.
