## **BY-LAW NUMBER 3317-80**

## of the

## TOWNSHIP OF WELLESLEY

To control street sales or sales on private and public properties during the local Apple Butter & Cheese Festival in the Village of Wellesley.

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wellesley enacts as follows;

- 1. (1) "person" means any individual, partnership, corporation, firm, association, club, society or any other organization.
  - (2) "Farmers Market Chairman" means the person elected each year to that position by the Wellesley Apple Butter & Cheese Festival Inc.
- 2. No person shall sell goods, canvas or solicit within the Settlement Boundaries of the Village of Wellesley, as defined in the official plan, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., on the day the Wellesley Apple Butter & Cheese Festival is being held unless that person has obtained a permit from the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wellesley. Council may consult with the Farmers Market Chairman for is recommendations on the granting of permits, and provided:
  - (1) The permit must be obtained for that year's Festival and must be obtained at least fifteen (15) days prior to the day of the Wellesley Apple Butter & Cheese Festival.
  - (2) Council shall have the authority to designate the location at which the person's sales activity will take place.
- 3. This By-law shall not apply to persons whose daily business is selling goods throughout the year within the settlement Boundaries of the Village of Wellesley, who are selling goods that they normally sell on a day to day basis.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars for each such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under The Provincial Offences Act, 1979.
