



Extended Administration Office Hours

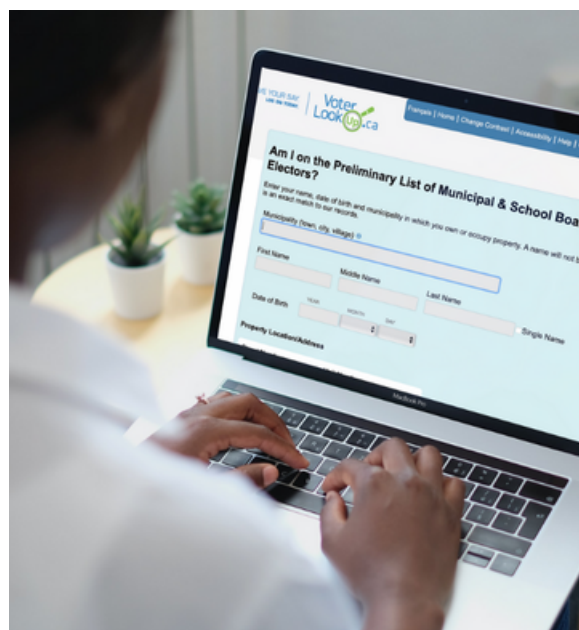

2022 Municipal Election

The next Municipal and School Board Election will take place on Monday, October 24, 2022. Important dates to remember as we move through summer into fall are;

- August 19, 2022: candidate nominations close at 2:00 p.m.
- October 14, 2022: start of 10 day voting period via internet and telephone
- October 24, 2022: Election Day (internet and telephone voting) voting ends at 8:00pm

The Township will host one (1) Election Help Centre. This Help Centre will be located at the Township of Wellesley Administration Office, 4639 Lobsinger Line, St. Clements. The hours of the Election Help Centre are daily from Friday, October 14, 2022 at 10:00a.m. to Election Day Monday, October 24, 2022 at 8:00p.m. Staff will also hold extended hours Tuesday, October 18 and Thursday, October 20, 2022 from 4:30p.m. to 6:00p.m. and Saturday, October 22, 2022 from 10:00a.m. to 2:00p.m.

Recreation Complex Progress

You may have noticed some activity at the Township of Wellesley Recreation land located at the corner of Queens Bush Road and Hutchison Road. On Thursday June 23, 2022 the earth moving equipment moved onto site. This is the start of what is intended to be a 18 month project that will feature many recreational opportunities for all residents of Wellesley Township. The Recreation Complex will feature many indoor amenities as well as new outdoor recreational amenities such as a new soccer park, a playground and skatepark, a multi use court and an extension to the Erbhaven Trails. Throughout the construction period, Erbhaven Trails will be required to be closed periodically.
