2025 Dog Tags Available Now

The Dog and Dog Kennel By-law requires every owner of a dog to register their dog with the Township and purchase a dog tag before the 31st day of March in each and every year or within twenty-one days after the dog comes into their possession.

Dog tags for the Township of Wellesley can be purchased in person (4639 Lobsinger Line, St. Clements) or online through the [Township website Dog Registration Form](#).

If your dog has not previously been registered please submit a veterinary certificate confirming spay/neuter with your application. If you have previously submitted proof, you are not required to resubmit.

Dog tags purchased before March 31st receive early bird pricing.



Winter Safety Reminders

- Stay away from snowplows/snow blowers.
- Don't play on roadside snow banks. Snow plow drivers or other drivers may not see you.
- Choose play areas away from roads, fences and water.
- Take extra caution when crossing roads.
- Snowballs should never be aimed at people or cars, instead, throw snowballs at safe targets, like trees or telephone poles.
- Building forts and tunnels should always be supervised by an adult.
- Don't put metal objects in your mouth. Lips and tongues can freeze to the metal.
- Don't eat snow, which can be dirty.

Winter Parking Restrictions

Traffic and Parking By-law 4/2021 prohibits parking on Township streets between the hours of 4:00am and 9:00am December 1st to March 31st without written request to the Township.

The Township of Wellesley restricts on street parking to provide safe snow removal and emergency services to Township residents. Parked cars can make plowing difficult and sometimes impossible. With your help, winter maintenance crews can plow faster and more efficiently.
